Dear Governor Hobbs:

On behalf of the Arizona State Land Department (ASLD), I am pleased to submit our Fiscal Year 2023 (FY 2023) Annual Report, pursuant to A.R.S. § 31-132. Following is a summary of ASLD's management activities and revenues collected during the fiscal year.

Over the past year, ASLD has been steadfast in its mission to actively manage the assets of a perpetual land trust for the support of the Beneficiaries and future generations of Arizonans. ASLD had another great year in FY 2023; as reflected in the financial results that follow.

During FY 2023, ASLD generated \$444 million total revenue, 92% of which will ultimately be distributed to Arizona K-12 Public Schools. This included \$359 million from the sale of land and long-term leases and \$14 million in royalties, both of which enhanced the Permanent Land Endowment Trust Fund. Additionally, the Department generated \$71 million from leases and interest, distributed directly to the Beneficiaries as expendable revenue.

Highlights of FY 2023 operations include:

• ASLD held 12 successful land sale auctions generating \$292 million in total value, on parcels that had a collective appraised value of \$265 million.

Which included the following notable auctions:

- 48 acres in Scottsdale on Nov. 16, 2022, for \$84 million to Honor Health
- 41 acres in Phoenix on Nov. 1, 2022, for \$44 million to Garden Deer Valley, LLC
- 115 acres in Phoenix on Jun. 28, 2023, for \$38 million to Reserve 100, LLC.
- 35 acres In Phoenix on Dec. 27, 2022, for \$29 million to Halle Properties, LLC.
- 116 acres in Phoenix on Dec. 21, 2022, for \$29 million to Vestar DRM-OPCO, LLC.
- 21 acres in Scottsdale on Mar. 8, 2023, for \$28 million to Legacy 76, LLC.

- ASLD strengthened its focus on supporting Resiliency, Water and Environmental initiatives. Some of these projects included:
 - Held a successful auction of a long-term solar lease in La Paz County, to Upstream HC-1, LLC. generating \$5 million. Additionally, we completed a study which identified 12 potential areas for sustainable solar facilities on State Trust Land (STL)
 - Initiated hydrology studies to assess the availability and value of ground water and long-term storage credits in Butler Vally and the Superstitions Vistas Planning area.
 - Partnered with the Department of Forestry and Fire Management (DFFM) to proactively treat 12,000 acres of STL for fire suppression and prevention.
- ASLD continued our focus on developing STL to increase the inventory of available land for housing and economic development through proactive due diligence investments and the creation of sustainable Zoning Banks (aka: Planned Community Districts & Planned Area Developments). Some of these projects included:
 - Established the zoning bank known as H2K with the City of Tucson, which targets advanced manufacturing, offering industrial users access to Interstate 10, the Union Pacific rail line and two major arterial roadways.
 - Invested over \$1 million on commercial due diligence projects for the Arizona Commerce Authority (ACA) designed to attract global corporations to relocate their corporate HQ and their clean energy manufacturing plants to Arizona

Thank you for the opportunity to serve the Trust Beneficiaries, our customers, stakeholders, and the people of Arizona, as State Land Commissioner. It is a privilege and honor for our ASLD team to continue advancing the interests of all those we serve, and to grow one of our State's largest economic development assets.





Total Trust Revenue Fiscal Year 2013 - 2023




Permanent Receipts Fiscal Year 2013 - 2023
