Prefix/Suffix Codes Used for Mineral Permits and Leases

The Arizona State Land Department uses the following prefix and suffix codes to identify different types of mineral leases and permits:

KE04	Common Variety Mineral Materials Lease
KE08	Mineral Exploration Permit (referred to as a “MEP”)
KE10	Geothermal Lease (exploration and production)
KE11	Mineral Lease
KE13	Oil and Gas Lease (exploration and production)
KE23	Special Land Use Permit (referred to as a “SLUP”)
